Additional dry cardboard can also be left next to your blue bin when the weather is dry. Please tear it up small and load it into one box small enough to fit back in your bin so the crew can re-fill and re-empty your bin for you. No additional bags can be left with grey or green bins.

Blue bin

Paper, card, newspaper, magazines, clean dry cardboard, junk mail.



Brown bin

Plastic pots, plastic tubs, plastic trays, glass bottles, jars, tins and cans.



Green bin

Garden waste, grass cuttings, small twigs and branches, leaves, plants.
