ALLOTMENT GARDENS Bull Haw Lane, Silkstone	Transferred to Parish Council on Local Government Reorganisation in 1974. Originally acquired by Penistone Rural District Council from Mary Grace Fullerton by Deed of Gift dated 6.5.1893
SILKSTONE WAR MEMORIAL AND CONGREGATION AREA Martin Croft, Silkstone	125 year lease from Barnsley MBC commenced 2011.
THE CHESTNUTS Off Martin Croft, Silkstone	Acquired 20.5.1987 from Thomas Gerald Wade by transfer via Barnsley MBC covenant.
Land on High Street High street, Silkstone	Leased from Barnsley MBC from June 1990 on a renewable 7 year lease. Obligation to maintain land and seat thereon. Not to use land for other than a landscaping scheme.
SILKSTONE RECREATION GROUND rear of petrol station, A628 Silkstone	Registered possessory title 6.8.1999. Acquired by deed of exchange 19.9.1946 from David William Fullerton covenant – land cannot be sold/exchanged/mortgaged with the consent of the charity commissioners
LAND AT TOWNGATE Towngate, Silkstone	Two small amenity areas. Land transferred from Jack Lunn (Homes) Ltd 31.8.1999
PARTS OF FORMER SILKSTONE WAGGON WAY Rear of properties on High Street & between pot house bridge, Barnsley road and Silkstone/Cawthorne parish boundary.	Acquired by conveyance from British Waterways Board 10.2.1989
THE ROSES Knabbs Lane,Silkstone Common	Subject to a licence agreement dated 28.9.2006 with Maple Estates (Silkstone) Ltd. Conveyance to Parish Council completed 15.9.09

LAND AT BEECH AVENUE Beech avenue, Silkstone Common	Parish Council has a licence to plan and maintain shrubs at the bottom of Beech ave. Licence from Barnsley MBC highways dated 16 July 1999.
ORCHARD WOOD Silkstone Common	Acquired 9.11.1987 from George Longden Estates by transfer via Barnsley MBC covenants for use as a public space.
JAYS WOOD Hall Royd Lane, Silkstone Common	125 year lease from Barnsley MBC commenced 2015.
